
Great Music at the Mountainside Library's Folk Music Café



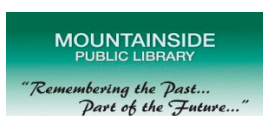


A favorite part of the night is the **song-share** where you can *dust off your instruments* and try out something. It's topped off with an **informal, live jam session** for everyone.
